0191:

The hospice must provide nursing care and services by or under the supervision of a registered nurse.

0100:

The hospice must ensure that specific general provisions requirements are met.

0101:

A hospice must maintain compliance with the conditions of this subpart and subparts D and E of this part

0105:

A hospice must provide all covered services in a manner consistent with accepted standards of practice.

0107:

The hospice must ensure that specific governing body requirements are met.

0146:

The hospice must ensure that specific interdisciplinary group requirements are met.

0190:

The hospice must ensure that specific nursing services requirements are met.

0212:

The hospice must ensure that specific medical supplies requirements are met

0304:

The hospice has an acceptable written plan, periodically rehearsed with staff, with procedures to be followed in the event of an internal or external disaster and for the care of casualties (patients and personnel) arising from such disasters.

0327:

The hospice must make provision for isolating patients with infectious diseases.
