R9-10-1404.B.	Personnel
R9-10-1404.C.2.	Personnel

0302:

R9-10-1404.B. Personnel shall attend orientation within the first week of employment. Orientation shall include personnel policies and procedures and patient rights.

0304:

R9-10-1404.C. Nursing personnel shall:

R9-10-1404.C.2. Be certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation within the first month of employment and maintain current certification thereafter;

0406:

R9-10-1405.A. The administrator shall appoint a director of nursing who shall be responsible for the management and supervision of nursing services which shall include the following:

R9-10-1405.A.4. Ensuring that each patient receives care and services based on the admission nursing assessment and the physician's orders; and

0603:

R9-10-1407.C. The administrator shall designate a food service manager who shall ensure that:
