THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES has found, under the authority of A.R.S. § 36-2232 et seq and Pursuant to Department of Health Services rules, that public necessity requires the operation of

ELOY FIRE DISTRICT dba ELOY FIRE DISTRICT AMBULANCE SERVICE

as a ground ALS and BLS ambulance service in the State of Arizona for the transportation of individuals who are sick, injured, wounded or otherwise incapacitated or helpless within the following service area, with the following central operations station and response times:

1. Service Area:

Beginning from the intersection of Pretzer & La Palma Roads, then north to Shay Road, then east ½ mile to the mid point of Section 21, T8S R8E, then north to Phillips, then east along Phillips to the southeast corner of Section 18, T8S R9E, then north to Hanna Road, then west along Hanna Road to the mid point of Section 9, T7S R8E, then north ½ mile to the center point of Section 9, T7S R8E, then west to La Palma Road, then south to Hanna Road, then west to 11 Mile Corner, then north to Cornman Road, then west to Signal Peak Road (Toltec Road), then south to Arica Road, then west to the northern boundary of Highway 84, then northwesterly along the northern boundary of Highway 84 to Overfield Road, then west to a point of 1923.20 feet east of Sunland Gin Road, then north 1327.86 feet, then west to Sunland Gin Road, then south 827.86 feet, then west 1,437 feet, then south 500 feet, then east 342.04 feet, then south to the northern right of way of Interstate 10, then southeasterly along the northern right of way of Interstate 10 314.96 feet, then south to the northern boundary line of Section 24, T7S R6E, then west 120.00 feet, then south 561.22 feet, then east to Sunland Gin Road, then south to the mid point of Section 24, T7S R6E, then west to the center point of Section 24, T7S R6E, then south to Shedd Road, then west along Shedd Road to the mid point of Section 26, T7S R6E, then south ¼ mile, then west to Henness Road, then north to Shedd Road,

Now, therefore, by virtue of the authority vested in the Arizona department of Health Services, under the constitution and laws of the State of Arizona, does hereby grant this

CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY

authorizing the operation of the aforesaid ambulance service for a period ending October 31, 2012 unless for cause sooner amended, suspended, revoked or terminated subject to the decisions and orders, and rules of the Department.

PROVIDED, that this certificate shall not be assigned nor transferred unless authorized by the Arizona Department of Health Services.

- b. *Fifteen (15) minutes on ninety-five (95) percent of all ambulance calls.*
- c. *Twenty (20) minutes on one hundred (100) percent of all ambulance calls.*
