**ASTR Database Information / Limitations:**

Only patients meeting the ASTR Trauma Patient Inclusion Definition are included in the ASTR database.  
 The ASTR database does not contain all fatal and non-fatal injury occurrences within Arizona. Injured patients will NOT be captured in the ASTR database if they:  
 1) Died at the scene and were not transferred to a trauma center, 2) Were treated only at a non-reporting hospital, or 3) Patient did not meet the ASTR trauma patient inclusion criteria.  
 A limited number of Arizona hospitals submit data to ASTR, but all designated Level I Trauma Centers report data to ASTR.  
 Designated Level I, Level II, and Level III Trauma Centers are required to submit to ASTR the full data set as indicated in state trauma registry rules.  
 Duplicate records may exist in the ASTR database for those patients who transferred from one trauma hospital to another during the course of their injury management.  
 Many required data element definitions and drop down menus were changed for 2008. It is important to account for these changes when comparing trauma registry data from multiple years.

Column Descriptions (for this document):

Tablename = ASTR Oracle table name in which the data element is stored

\*Note on ASTR Trauma One Oracle tables: In the ASTR Oracle database, "acctno" is the common key field in all Oracle tables and the MAINDATA table is the primary table. The "acctno" field is auto-generated by the ASTR Trauma One system.

Field Name = Field Name in Record Layout

Field Type = Indicates whether the value is Character, Numeric, Date, etc.

Field Width = The maximum amount of characters

Data Element Description = The Description of the Element or Field Prompt in the record layout

Picklist (Yes/No) = Indicates whether there is a picklist

Picklist / Subpicklist Names = The name of the primary and subpicklist

Data Value = Indicates value stored in Record Layout

Data Value Descriptions = The description of the primary picklist and subvalue picklist. Changes made to required picklists are outlined in Appendix G.
