**SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENT
#SP-077-PHS-EMS**

Interpretation of “Rapid infuser system” in 9 A.A.C. 25, Article 13, Exhibit I

This substantive policy statement is advisory only. A substantive policy statement does not include internal procedural documents that only affect the internal procedures of the agency and does not impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties or include confidential information or rules made in accordance with the Arizona Administrative Procedure Act. If you believe that this substantive policy statement does impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties, you may petition the agency under Arizona Revised Statutes § 41-1033 for a review of the statement.

The purpose of this substantive policy statement is to notify the public how the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) interprets the language “Rapid infuser system” in 9 A.A.C. 25, Article 13, Exhibit I, Arizona Trauma Center Standards.

Exhibit I provides that a “Rapid infuser system” is essential and required in both the emergency department and the operating room of a Level I, II, III, or IV trauma center. See 9 A.A.C. 25, Article 13, Exhibit I, subsections (E)(5)(b)(xv) and (E)(6)(i).

ADHS interprets “Rapid infuser system” in this context to mean any method or equipment used to rapidly infuse fluids to trauma patients.

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
