




## Public-Private Partnership Opportunity



### 4.2.3 Approx. 23 beds at the Community Reintegration Unit (CRU)

The Community Reintegration Unit (CRU) facility is an extension of our Forensic Campus. The facility was originally built for adolescent patients, but stopped serving that population due to chronically low census. The facility is currently operating, so it should be considered turn-key. This unit includes numerous classrooms, a weight room, an open yard area, and a swimming pool.

- The design of the building allows for single or multiple patient occupancy in the rooms
- This facility contains central staff/nursing station layout
- The design of the existing facility and land availability allows for additional buildings to be constructed if desired
