Infant Nutrition Video Study Guide

Based on the information presented in this video, discuss the following points with your supervisor or trainer.

- 1. Review the infant nutrition and feeding policies and procedures for your program. Discuss your program's policies and procedures with your trainer or more experienced staff member to ensure you feel you are ready to implement these policies and procedures in your program. Compare and contrast the information presented in this video with the information currently in place in your program. List one practice that could be added to your program OR list how you can improve one practice already in place.
- 2. The narrator presented a list of foods that could be dangerous to feed to infants. Discuss these items with your trainer or a more experienced staff member and <u>create a list</u> of alternative foods that you could safely offer to infants in place of these foods. Does your program include a list of foods that are not to be offered to infants?
- 3. Rhiannon discussed the importance of maintaining a one-on-one feeding experience for infants. Discuss how you can provide this type of feeding experience in your infant program and then list the main points.
- 4. Nina discussed some ideas for feeding an infant with special needs. If an infant with an identified special need were to enroll in your program, how would you make sure this infant's needs are met? Describe the plan.
