THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES has found, under the authority of A.R.S. § 36-2232 et seq and Pursuant to Department of Health Services rules, that public necessity requires the operation of

## CITY OF TUCSON dba TUCSON FIRE DEPARTMENT

as a ground ALS ambulance service in the State of Arizona for the transportation of individuals who are sick, injured, wounded or otherwise incapacitated or helpless within the following service area, with the following central operations station and response times:

**1. Service Area:**

*Legal corporate city limits of the City of Tucson.*

**2. Central Operating Station:**

*300 S. Fire Central Place, Tucson, AZ 85701.*

**3. Response Times:**

- a. Eight (8) minutes fifty-nine (59) seconds on ninety (90) percent of all ambulance calls.*
- b. Ten (10) minutes on ninety-five (95) percent of all ambulance calls.*
- c. Fifteen (15) minutes on ninety-seven (97) percent of all ambulance calls.*
- d. Twenty (20) minutes on one hundred (100) percent of all ambulance calls.*

**4. Type of Service:**

*Immediate Response Transports.*

**5. Hours of Operation:**

*24 hours per day – 7 days per week*

Now, therefore, by virtue of the authority vested in the Arizona Department of Health Services, under the constitution and laws of the State of Arizona, does hereby grant this

authorizing the operation of the aforesaid ambulance service for a period ending September 30, 2018 unless for cause sooner amended, suspended, revoked or terminated subject to the decisions and orders, and rules of the Department.

PROVIDED, that this certificate shall not be assigned nor transferred unless authorized by the Arizona Department of Health Services.
