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Base Hospital General Information

The Bureau of Emergency Medical Services & Trauma System certifies all Advanced Life Support Base Hospitals in Arizona. Base Hospitals provide both administrative medical direction and on-line medical direction to certified emergency medical technicians at the advanced life support level which includes, but is not limited to, Paramedics.

To become certified as an Arizona Base Hospital, submission of a Bureau approved application is required. It is recommended that an applicant review Arizona Administrative Code [R9-25-208](#) for specific details about eligibility and application requirements.

Upon receipt of your application the Bureau will conduct an on-site visit to evaluate compliance with Statutes and Rules. Once certified, the hospital is audited every two years.
