What is AZ MyIR?

- Web-based program that allows healthcare providers to give patients direct access to copies of their official immunization records from the state registry
- Goals are to:
 - Reduce administrative burdens for providers
 - Improve overall health by increasing immunization rates
 - Empower consumers to take greater control of their own health and that of their family members

Project Overview

- Compliant with state and federal law
- Simplifies and expands on existing processes to deliver vaccine records to individuals
- Leverages existing state immunization registry to retrieve patient-specific records and vaccine forecasts
- Blue Button-capable

How It Works with the State Registry

- AZ MyIR is a consumer portal that connects with ASIIS.
- The program allows patients to view and print official copies of their immunization records.
- Patients will have direct access only to their approved records.
- Patients will not have access to ASIIS – AZ MyIR is a separate portal.
- All changes and updates to vaccine records are by providers only within ASIIS.

Provider Office Role

- One-time enrollment process per patient.
 - Enrollment process is typically completed in less than 2 minutes.
 - Authenticate patients and approve requests for accounts.
- Provide patients with materials that offer step-by-step instructions for accessing copies of their immunization records.

Provider-Initiated Patient Registration

1. Register.



Patient completes an AZ MyIR registration form in your office.

2. Request.



Your office reviews and approves the application during the visit, matches records to ASIIS, and provides the patient with a temporary password/PIN and a program user guide.

3. Review.



The patient logs in at home, uses the temporary password/PIN to activate the account, and creates a new password. The patient now has immediate access to family immunization records.

Consumer-Initiated Patient Registration

1. Register.



Patient pre-registers for AZ MyIR and sets their own password/PIN before visiting your office.

2. Request.



Your office reviews and approves the application in person, matches records to ASIIS and gives the patient a program user guide.

3. Review.



Patient logs in at home, activates the account and has immediate access to copies of immunization records anytime, anywhere through AZ.MyIR.net.
