

## BE SUNWISE & PLAY SUN SMART SKIN CANCER PREVENTION POSTER CONTEST!

**1** Arizona residents 17 years and younger are eligible to participate.

2 Poster submissions should demonstrate ways to prevent skin cancer and raise sun safety awareness. Examples: protecting skin with clothing, wearing a wide-brimmed hat, limiting time in the midday sun, seeking shaded or indoor activities in middle of the day, using sunscreen & checking the ultraviolet (UV) index.

Posters must be original content only. Use of the Arizona Diamondbacks logo, personnel, or characters (e.g. D. Baxter the Bobcat) is permitted.

Posters must be on unlined paper 8 ½" by 11" in size. Electronic entries cannot be accepted.

5 Send posters to Bianca Arriaga, Arizona Department of Health Services SunWise Program, 150 N. 18th Ave. Suite 140, Phoenix, Arizona 85007-3245. Posters must be received by 5 p.m. on Monday, March 20, 2017.

6 A completed entry form must be photocopied onto the back of or attached to the back of each poster.

**7** Judging will take place on or before Monday, April 17, 2017.

**B**Judges reserve the right to disqualify an entry that does not conform to the rules.

P There will be 50 semifinalists, with at least 2 semifinalists from each grade level (pre-K through high school).

- **10** First prize is 4 tickets for the artist to the Arizona Diamondbacks vs. Pittsburgh Pirates baseball game in Phoenix on Saturday, May 13, 2017. The winning artist & teacher will receive on-field awards and have their photos taken. The winning artwork will be chosen by the Diamondbacks. The artwork will be professionally reproduced for use in a state-wide skin cancer prevention campaign.
- 1 The teacher of the winning artist will also receive 2 tickets to the game.
- 12 The teacher and winning artist must agree to appear in promotional activities including press releases and interviews. An affidavit of Eligibility, Release of Liability and Assignment/License Agreement provided by ADHS must be signed for the student upon notification of the award. All posters become the property of ADHS and the Arizona Diamondbacks.
