
Valley Fever is an infection caused by breathing in fungal spores found in hot, dry places like Arizona




MORE THAN 100,000 PEOPLE IN ARIZONA ARE INFECTED WITH VALLEY FEVER EVERY YEAR

40 OF EVERY 100

infected people become sick with symptoms such as cough, fever, fatigue, rash, and night sweats.



5 will have severe pneumonia and need treatment



In less than 1 in 100, the disease spreads outside the lungs and can cause serious symptoms

People who become sick with Valley Fever:

- can be ill for weeks or months
- can miss two weeks of work or school



In 2014:

- more than 700 people were hospitalized with Valley Fever
- these hospitalizations cost more than \$51 million
