# Pesticide Labels Contain:

- **Ingredients:** What's in the product? Is it a Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP)?
- **Signal word:** how toxic is the product?
- **Precautionary statements:** How can the product be used safely?
- **First aid information:** What should I do if it gets in my eyes, mouth, lungs or skin?
- **Environmental hazards:** What special restrictions are put on this product to protect the environment?
- **Personal protective equipment:** What should I wear? Should I wear gloves when I use this product?
- **Directions for use:** How and where should I use the product? How much is ok?
- **Storage and disposal:** How does the product have to be stored? What should I do with any leftover product?

# Pesticide Safety Trainings-Read the Label

- Pesticide labels contain detailed information on how to use the product correctly and legally.
- Use appropriate amount of pesticide to ensure it is effective at controlling the pest.
- Do not assume that a type of pesticide can be used in another setting.
- Proper use, storage and/or disposal-out of reach of children and/or pets.
- Never remove a pesticide label from the container or use unlabeled pesticides.

- **Tribal Pesticide Program Council**-The TPPC *is a tribal technical resource and program and policy* dialogue and development group, focused on pesticide issues and concerns. It is composed of authorized representatives from federally recognized tribes and Indian nations and intertribal organizations.
- **Other State Councils/Organizations/Committees**-consist of pesticide inspection officers that enforce the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), promote the protection of the health, environment and public against the misuse of pesticides.
