Submitting redundant pages not only takes longer to process, they eventually end up in recycle bins.**

 - a. **EPA Method 200.8 for Testing Uranium in Wastewater; Determination of Trace Elements in Waters and Wastes by Inductively Coupled Plasma – Mass Spectrometry, Revision 5.4;**
 - b. **Method D 99-003 Free Chlorine Species (HOCl-and OCl-) by Test Strip for field testing;**
 - c. **GLI Method 2 for testing Turbidity November 2, 1992, Available at: Great Lakes Instruments Inc., 8855 North 55th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53223, for field testing.**
