## Reminders

1. The new Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2006-2008 Food List is in full effect as of November 1, 2005. Vendors should **no longer** be allowing participants to shop from the FFY 2003-2005 Food List.

Also, it has been brought to the attention of the Arizona WIC Program that many participants do not have their own copy of the FFY 2006-2008 Food List. It is not the responsibility of the Vendor to be distributing and training on the new food items. Please advise these participants to return to their local WIC office for assistance and proper training on the new Food List.

2. The Arizona WIC Program has switched to gallon size milk containers only for most participants. Participants are not allowed to combine different sizes of milk to make up the gallon size.

However, you will see some food instruments that **specify** half gallons or quarts. The food instrument will say: "(HALF GALLON CONTAINER ONLY) or (HALF GALLON OR QUART CONTAINERS ONLY)." This is **only allowed** if the food instrument specifies half gallon and/or quart containers.

3. When WIC participants are utilizing the "buy one get one free" special, please remember that the item being purchased with the WIC food instrument must be a WIC authorized item. The free item does not have to be WIC authorized.
4. Hickman's Eggs can be found in two different types. The regular Arizona Grown Hickman's large white eggs, and the Arizona Grown Hickman's large white eggs – Golden Yolk. The Golden Yolk Eggs are considered "specialty" eggs and **are not** WIC authorized.
