**Description:** The National Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services (CLAS) Standards in Health and Health Care, developed by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Minority Health, are intended to advance health equity, improve quality and help eliminate healthcare disparities. The CLAS Standards were launched initially in 2000 and enhanced in April 2013 with expansion of conceptualization of culture, audience, health and recipients. The online training, provided by the Arizona Department of Health Services, is an introduction to CLAS Standards, including five interactive modules.
