Overview

Medical Electronic Disease Surveillance Intelligence System (MEDSIS) is the statewide disease surveillance system hosted by ADHS. It is an online, real-time reporting system for Arizona clinicians for all reportable conditions.

Opioid Reporting

The Governor's Enhanced Surveillance Advisory makes the following diagnoses reportable within 24 hours.

- Suspected Opioid Overdose
- Suspected Opioid Overdose Death
- Neonatal abstinence syndrome

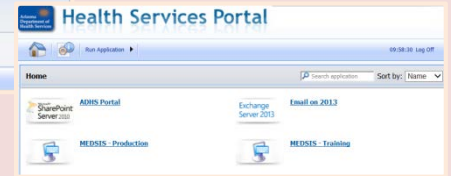
Signing In

Step 1. Visit the Health Service Portal (<https://my.health.azdhs.gov>)

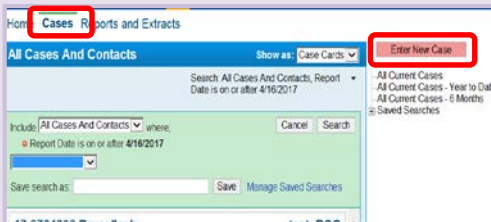
Step 2. Login to HSP with given username & password

Step 3. Click on **MEDSIS – Training** icon to practice

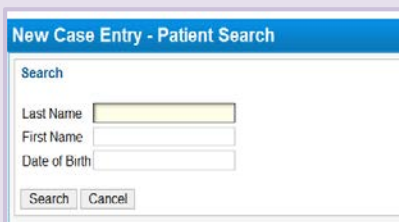
Step 4. Click on **MEDSIS – Production** icon to report cases



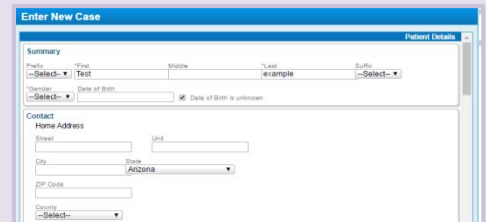

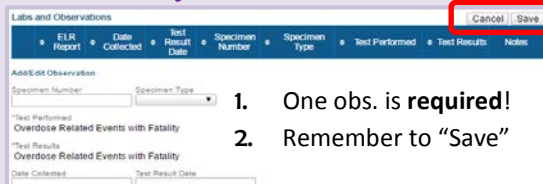
Click on "Cases" → Enter New Case



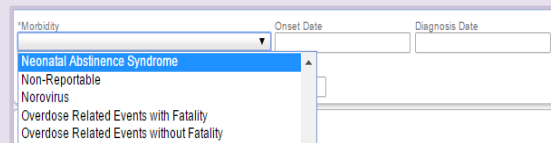

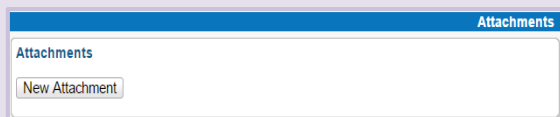

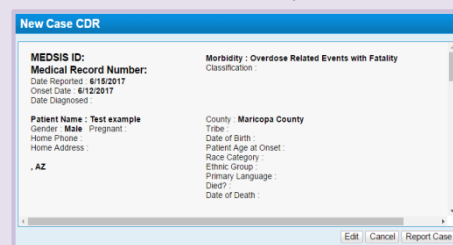
