Your baby did not pass the second hearing screen. We are concerned that your baby may have a hearing loss. It is important that your baby is scheduled for a diagnostic hearing test as soon as possible (before three months of age is best).

Your baby must sleep for the test. Under three months of age, the testing is usually done while the baby sleeps naturally. After a baby is older or if the baby does not sleep for the test, sedation may be needed to complete it. Take this paper to your baby's doctor to get a referral. They can help you make an appointment with a pediatric audiologist for an Auditory Brainstem Response (ABR) test.
