NUCLEOSIDE/NUCLEOTIDE REVERSE TRANSCRIPTASE INHIBITORS

**USE GUIDELINES

***On February 18, 2005, the National Alliance of State and Territorial AIDS Directors (NASTAD) announced that AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) clients now have access to the first national program to provide free medicine for the treatment of chronic hepatitis C. This Schering-Plough initiative, known as the *Commitment to Community Program*, will provide a full course of combination therapy. Treatment will be provided as long as slots for the Schering program remain available.
