

# COVID-19 Vaccine

## Prioritization Phase By Arizona County

Arizona COVID-19 vaccine is allocated through local and tribal health jurisdictions. The map below shows which age group each county is currently vaccinating. In order to be vaccinated, **you will need to be a member of the current group**, schedule an appointment, and provide appropriate identification once you arrive at the vaccination site.

**Frontline Essential Workers:** Counties and tribes may also choose to vaccinate the following groups defined by [ACIP](#) as a subset of essential workers at highest risk for work-related exposure.

- Food and agriculture
- Grocery store, convenience store, and carniceria workers
- U.S. Postal Service
- Manufacturing workers
- Public transit workers, including buses, Light Rail, Uber, Lyft, taxis, and rideshare
- State and local government workers
- Funeral home workers

**NOTE:** FDA EUA-approved age groups will be followed during vaccine administration (16 and older for the Pfizer vaccine, 18 and older for the Moderna and Janssen vaccines).
