Volunteer Responsibilities

- Developing a curriculum and providing guidance to participants
- Facilitate engaging and interactive workshops focused on key life skills
- Foster a positive and respectful environment for learning
- Collaborate with hospital staff to track progress, provide feedback, and ensure the educational content aligns with treatment goals.

Qualifications

- No formal teaching experience required, but a passion for supporting others is a must!
- A willingness to share knowledge and engage with individuals from diverse backgrounds
- Empathy, patience, and a non-judgmental attitude
- Experience in any of the following areas is a plus: education, coaching, financial literacy, or career development.

Time Commitment

- Volunteers are asked to commit at least two (2) hours per month, with each session lasting approximately one (1) hour, depending on the subject matter
- The Hospital is flexible in scheduling to accommodate your availability.
