To All Arizona Law Enforcement Agencies:

The Arizona Medical Marijuana program is launching on Thursday, April 14, 2011. The Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) has implemented a new Medical Marijuana Card Verification website for use by Arizona law enforcement agencies.

To use this website, please identify the appropriate users within your agency and have them register at <https://azmmr.azdhs.gov>. ADHS will review the registrations and approve those from law enforcement agencies.

Once registered, law enforcement personnel will be able to access the Arizona Medical Marijuana Card Verification website at <https://azmmv.azdhs.gov>. This website will accept the 20-digit registry identification card number, and if valid, it will provide the name of the card holder (and when available, the amount of marijuana dispensed in the last 60 days). Please note that both of these website links will be operational on April 14.

Identification cards for patients, caregivers and dispensary agents will include name, address, photo, issue date, expiration date, birth date, whether or not the person is approved to cultivate (patient and caregiver cards) and the legal name of the registered dispensary (dispensary agent cards). Caregiver cards will include registry identification numbers for both the designated caregiver and his or her patient. Identification cards will include a magnetic strip and a 2D barcode that includes the card holder's name and registry identification number. Security features will include a holographic image laminate and UV linking.
