### NONIONIZING Registration Application and Annual Renewal Fee Schedule

The Nonionizing Compliance program charges an APPLICATION FEE for new applicants as well as an ANNUAL FEE for existing registrations. Fees are in accordance with the fee schedule below.

<b>Medical Radiofrequency (RM)</b> -Includes: RF, EC, Diathermy	F12	\$100	Site fee	Site fee of \$100.00

Payment of the **APPLICATION FEE** is required for an application to be considered complete. Check payments should be included with [application](#) and may be made payable to ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.

Payment of the **ANNUAL FEE** must be made via the online payment portal accessible at [AZDHS.GOV/NONION](http://AZDHS.GOV/NONION). Annual Fee Courtesy Notices are typically sent out between October and December the preceding year and payment is due by January 1. Fee is considered late on January 2 even if a Courtesy Notice was not received. In the event one is not received, this fee schedule is your invoice.

Note there is no fee for adding units during the year. Likewise, there are no refunds for removing units during the year. The annual fee for the following year will reflect the unit inventory change.
