THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES has found, under the authority of A.R.S. § 36-2232 et seq and Pursuant to Department of Health Services rules, that public necessity requires the operation of

CENTRAL ARIZONA FIRE AND MEDICAL AUTHORITY dba CAFMA

as a ground ALS and BLS ambulance service in the State of Arizona for the transportation of individuals who are sick, injured, wounded or otherwise incapacitated or helpless within the following service area, with the following central operations station and response times:

1. **Legal Address:** *8603 E. Eastridge Dr., Prescott Valley, AZ 86314*
2. **Type of Service:** *Immediate Response Transports*
3. **Hours of Operation:** *24 hours per day – 7 days per week*
4. **Service Area:** *The service area is the geographical area within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Central Arizona Fire and Medical Authority. The boundary is comprised of the Central Yavapai Fire District boundary and the Chino Valley Fire District boundary.*
5. **Response Times:**
 - a) *Prescott Valley town limits within Central Yavapai Fire District Boundaries:*
 1. *Ten (10) minutes, zero seconds (10:00) on 90% of all ambulance calls.*
 2. *Fifteen (15) minutes, zero seconds (15:00) on 95% of all ambulance calls.*
 3. *Twenty-five (25) minutes, zero seconds (25:00) on 98% of all ambulance calls.*

Now, therefore, by virtue of the authority vested in the Arizona Department of Health Services, under the constitution and laws of the State of Arizona, does hereby grant this

INITIAL

CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY

authorizing the operation of the aforesaid ambulance service for a period ending April 26, 2025 unless for cause sooner amended, suspended, revoked or terminated subject to the decisions and orders, and rules of the Department.

PROVIDED, that this certificate shall not be assigned nor transferred unless authorized by the Arizona Department of Health Services.

- b) Chino Valley town limits within Chino Valley Fire District Boundaries:*
- 1. Ten (10) minutes, zero seconds (10:00) on 85% of all ambulance calls.*
 - 2. Fifteen (15) minutes, zero seconds (15:00) on 95% of all ambulance calls.*
 - 3. Thirty (30) minutes, zero seconds (30:00) on 98% of all ambulance calls.*
- c) All other areas in the Central Yavapai and Chino Valley Fire Districts (CAFMA) not specifically mentioned above:*
- 1. Twenty minutes, zero seconds (20:00) on 90% of all ambulance calls.*
 - 2. Twenty-five (25) minutes, zero seconds (25:00) on 95% of all ambulance calls.*
 - 3. Forty-five (45) minutes, zero seconds (45:00) on 98% of all ambulance calls.*
