





- ❖Classified as "Probable Travel Related Case"
- Conducted educational outreach in one (1) mile radius





- Establish radius at risk (150 meters)
- Identify target population
- Target time frame
- ❖ Develop Outcome Formula
- ❖ Data Collection
- Community Surveillance Teams
  - Environmental Health & Education
  - Clinical
  - Epi Response Teams



#### Epi & Clinical Response

- Epi consultations & urine sample collection
- This team coordinated for specimen collection
- Extended clinic hours to assist providers with testing demand
- Coordinated provider workshop with Women's Health and Family Planning Association of Texas (WHFPT) in response to CDC testing guideline change for pregnant women
- Provided updates to Administration
- Exercised Health Authority involvement and direction





#### **Environmental Health & Education**

- Designated Vector Lead
- Communicated scope of response efforts with City of Brownsville/City of San Benito
- Collaborated with state regional office and municipalities
- Information Sharing
- Support to City of Brownsville/City of San Benito in vector surveillance
- Municipality vector programs were first group to be informed of case situation



Interviews, n = 273




Days later, four (4) additional locally acquired Zika cases were identified from the Community Surveillance Efforts


