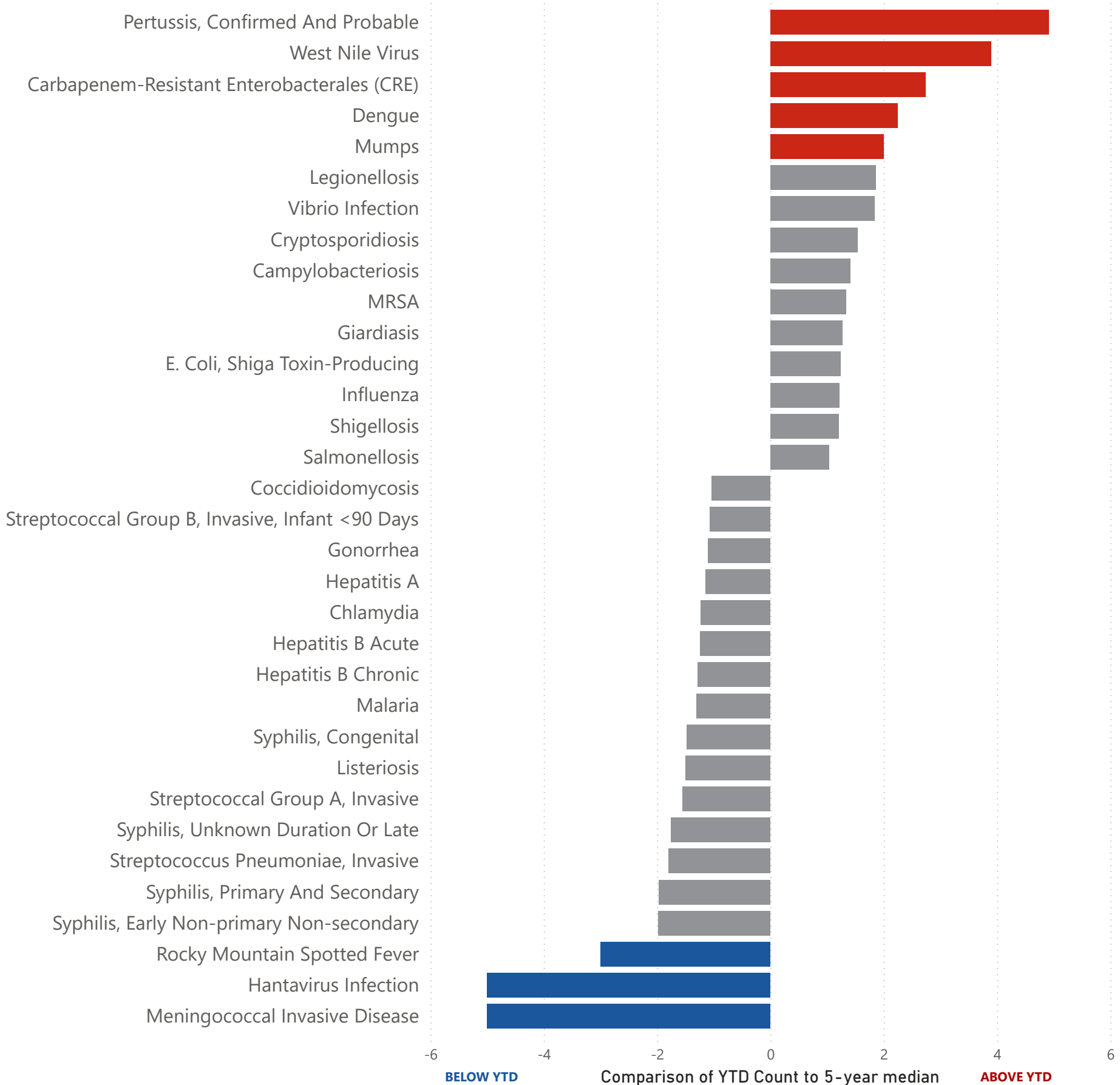


SUMMARY OF SELECTED REPORTABLE DISEASES

- Mumps
- Pertussis, Confirmed And Probable
- West Nile Virus

The following morbidities have a YTD count at least **2 times less** than their 5-year medians:

- Hantavirus Infection
- Meningococcal Invasive Disease
- Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever

The following morbidities are not shown, due to a YTD count or 5-year median = 0:

- Chikungunya
- H.Flu B All Ages
- Measles
- Zika

<sup>3</sup> During 2026, the 5-year median includes cases reported 2021 through 2025.

<sup>4</sup> Influenza is lab-confirmed only and represents “season-to-date” cases (counting from the previous September) rather than year-to-date.

<sup>5</sup> Congenital syphilis cases are counted in their year of birth; counts may vary as additional cases can be reported at any time.

<sup>6</sup> Note that cases can have multiple mechanisms identified and therefore will be counted in multiple mechanism categories.
