EXPLANATION OF **Labeling Requirements**

The following information is required by law.

Cottage Food products must be packaged at home with an attached label in a clear and legible printed or handwritten font which includes the following:

The product's production date

-This date specifies when the product was made, not when it was packaged.

The name and registration of the food preparer

-Your registration number can be found on the Cottage Food Certificate emailed upon approval of your registration.

A list of all ingredients in the product

-If you're taking a commercially packaged product, altering it, then packaging it again, you must include all ingredients listed in the commercially packaged item AND all the ingredients added.

This exact statement: "This product was produced in a home kitchen that may come in contact with common food allergens and pet allergens and is not subject to public health inspection.

-A residential kitchen cannot guarantee the absence of allergens.

If applicable for the product: "This product was made in a facility by individuals with developmental disabilities.

This information must be displayed on the outside of the package but, it can be labeled separately. For example, it may be easier to use a separate sticker for the production date rather than customizing each product label.
