### How to Search a Student in ASIIS

Another way to search is to just put in the initials only of the first and last name, and then the birthday. When you select the Search button, a list of records will show up in the Patient Search Results. You can then look through the list to find your student's name and when you select or click on the correct name, it will take you to the next screen.

Step 3: Once you select your student, you will first see the Patient Demographic Screen. As you cannot enter or edit data, there is nothing to do here. Providers are the ones who update this screen when a patient comes in to be vaccinated. Information on this screen could help you make sure this is the correct student you are looking for.

Step 4: Look for Vaccinations on the left hand menu and then select Summary option.

The Summary View is an easy and clear way to review the vaccine groups, and the number and dates of when vaccines were given. Using the Arizona Guide to Required Vaccinations for School (or Child Care) Entry, you can then determine if your student has everything they need for their age or if they need to be referred for additional vaccines. In the case of Minnie, entering kindergarten, she is lacking certain vaccines.

In some cases this may mean the student needs additional doses to meet school requirements. Even if the student obtains additional doses, the invalid date will stay in the Summary Report. You do not need to enter the invalid date(s) into your school software system or the ASIR.

Additional information about the dose, why it may be invalid, and who gave the vaccination can be found if you **click on the date of the vaccine you want to examine.** In this case, we have selected the DTaP dose given on 3/21/2018 (record on previous slide). This shows us it was a combination vaccine, and that the X is saying an expired vaccine as given, making the components invalid. In addition, it is saying that the hepatitis B part of this vaccine was an extraneous (but valid) dose that did not need to be given as the student had already received 3 valid and appropriate doses.

Please remember the forecast is based on ACIP recommendations and may differ from Arizona school requirements and guidance.

Due Now -- As of today's date, the patient's age falls between the recommended minimum age and the recommended maximum age for this dose and the absolute minimum interval has been met since the last dose.

Past Due -- As of today's date, the recommended maximum age or the recommended maximum date for this dose has passed.

Not Yet Due -- As of today's date, the patient is not due or past due.

Optional -- This vaccine may be administered today. Although the usual "recommended" date has not been met, the minimum valid date for this dose has been met.

### Reviewing the View/Add Screen

Another screen you may find helpful is the View/Add option. Select Vaccinations from the left hand menu and then select View/Add. This gives a view of the individual vaccine presentations that were given with more explanation of certain symbols. It shows if the vaccine was a single antigen or a combination vaccine. Although used more in a clinical setting, these may be helpful to some school health office personnel.

### **Inactive Status**

If you see this status, there is nothing you need to do and you can proceed with review of the record.

# Q: I can't find a record in ASIIS for my student. What does that mean?

- A: If there is no record in ASIIS, it may be because:
  - 1) the provider(s) did not enter the data into ASIIS
  - the student is from a different state or country (and data has not been entered in as historical yet)
  - 3) the person you are searching was born more than 25 years ago and their data was never entered into ASIIS
  - 4) the patient record may be merged with another record.

#### **Q:** Why are some records incomplete in ASIIS?

A: You may see some records in ASIIS that do not show a lot of vaccination dates or are an incomplete record. The reason is similar to the answers in the previous slide. As a school health office, you may have additional records from the parent, a provider, or from another state that will help to fill in gaps and make a complete record that is recorded in your school software system or on the Arizona School Immunization Record (ASIR).

You can recommend to parents that they take all the records into their provider and ask them to enter the data into ASIIS as historical data. The county health departments (CHDs) will also do this.

It is very important to keep the most recent and complete original immunization records in the student health file, even after you enter the dates in your school software system or on the Arizona School Immunization Record (ASIR).



### Q: When was ASIIS developed and by whom?

A: The Arizona State Immunization Information System (ASIIS) was developed in late-1998 by Scientific Technologies Corporation (STC) for the Arizona Immunization Program and the first data was entered soon after that. ASIIS started out as a way to capture immunization data for children, but as it is now over 20 years old, it has become a lifetime registry and is able to capture adult information as well. Individuals who were born before 1998 are unlikely to have had their childhood data entered into ASIIS unless they have requested that their provider put the records in (as historical data). Other adult vaccinations may have been entered, either by a county health department, a provider, or a pharmacist, who is required by law to enter the data into ASIIS.



#### Q: Why can't we get information from other states' IIS systems?

A: Each state develops its own Immunization Information Systems (IIS). STC developed ASIIS for Arizona but also has developed systems for at least 9 other states. Any changes or upgrades usually have to be approved by the 'consortium' of states. Other states have developed their own independent products. Not all systems talk to each other, and then there is the issue of privacy (HIPAA, FERPA, etc.) that does not (yet) allow for you to request information from other states. The CDC, STC, and many other states continue to work on this possibility, but we are not there yet.
