

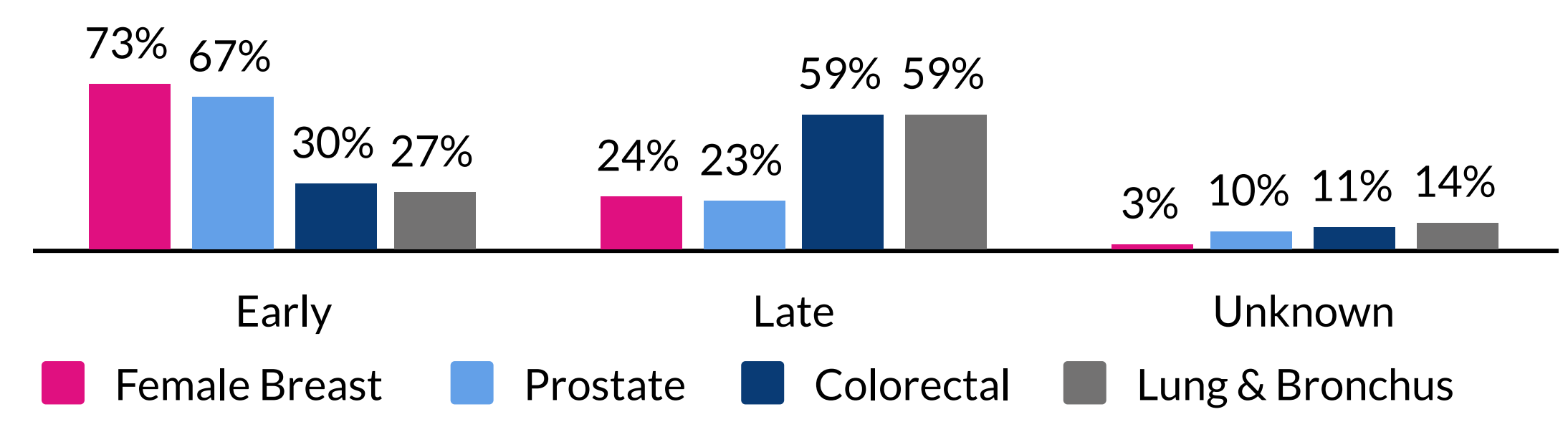
In 2019, there were a total of **34,445** cases of invasive cancer

daily, there were approximately **94**

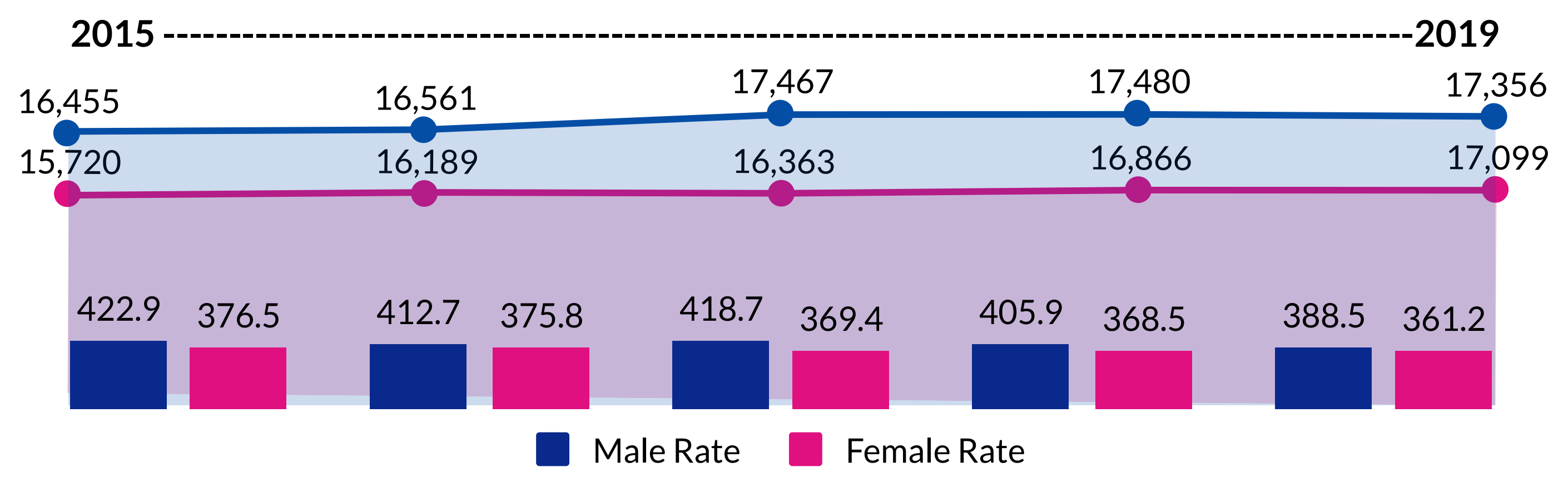
Stage at Diagnosis - 2019

Early Stage = Confined to site where cancer started.

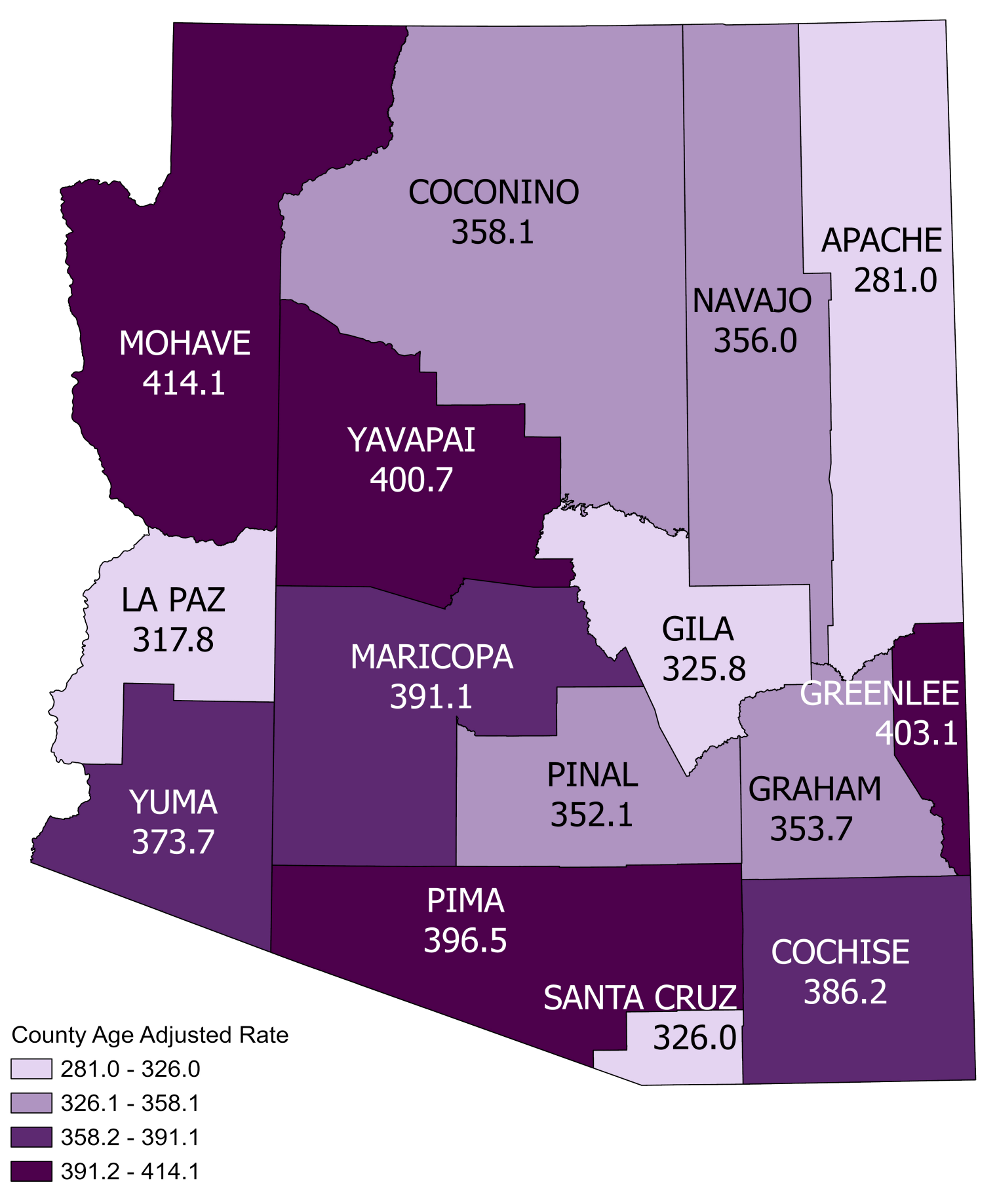
Late Stage = Cancer has spread to lymph nodes or other parts of the body.



Case Count & Rate by Gender



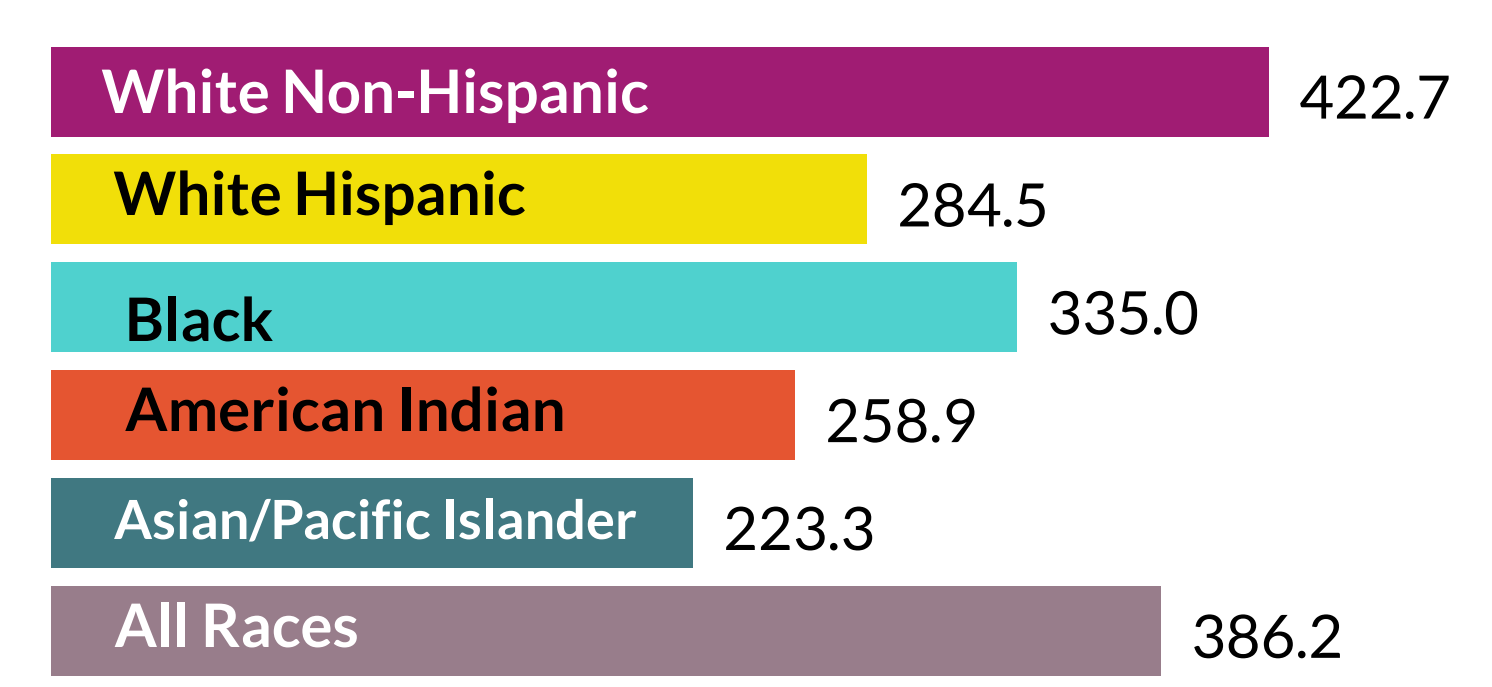
Incidence Rates by County 2015-2019

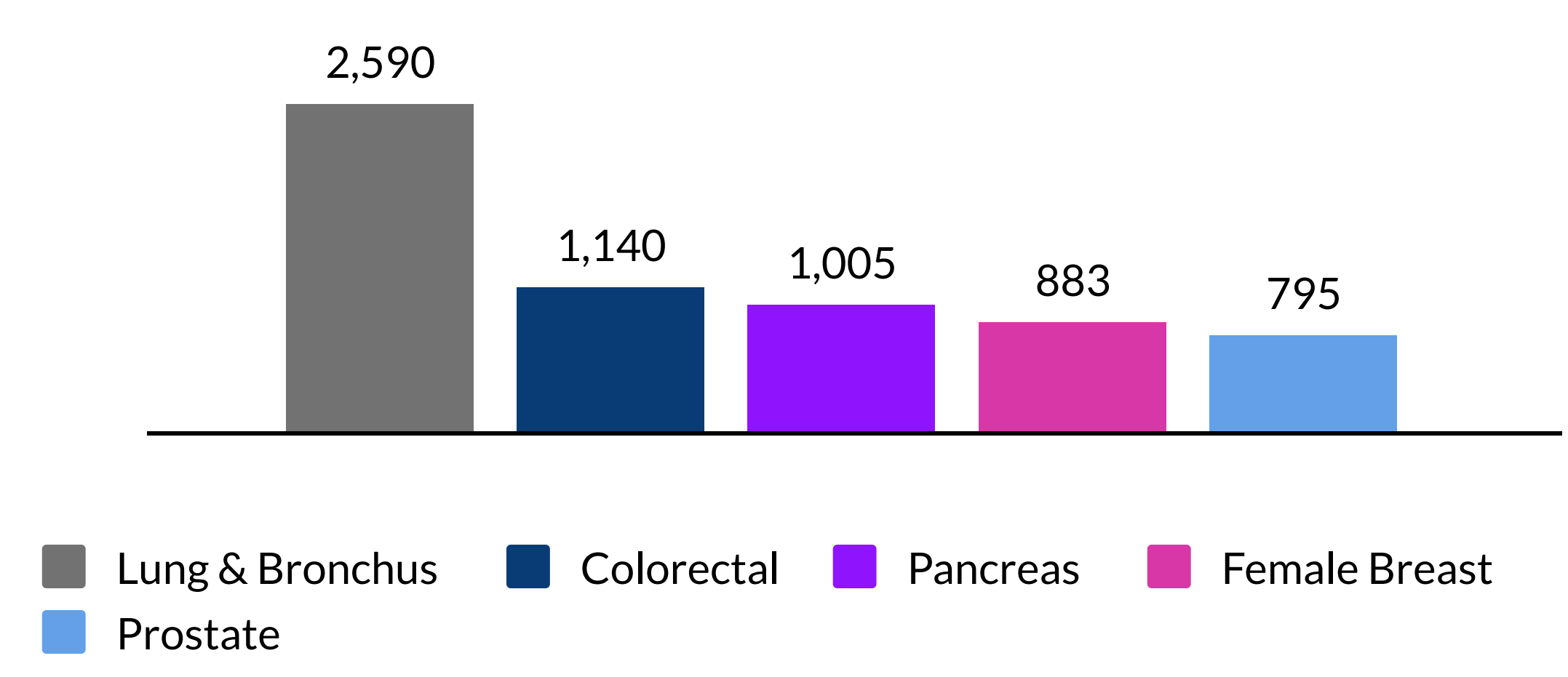

Incidence Rate by Race/Ethnicity per 100,000 persons 2015-2019

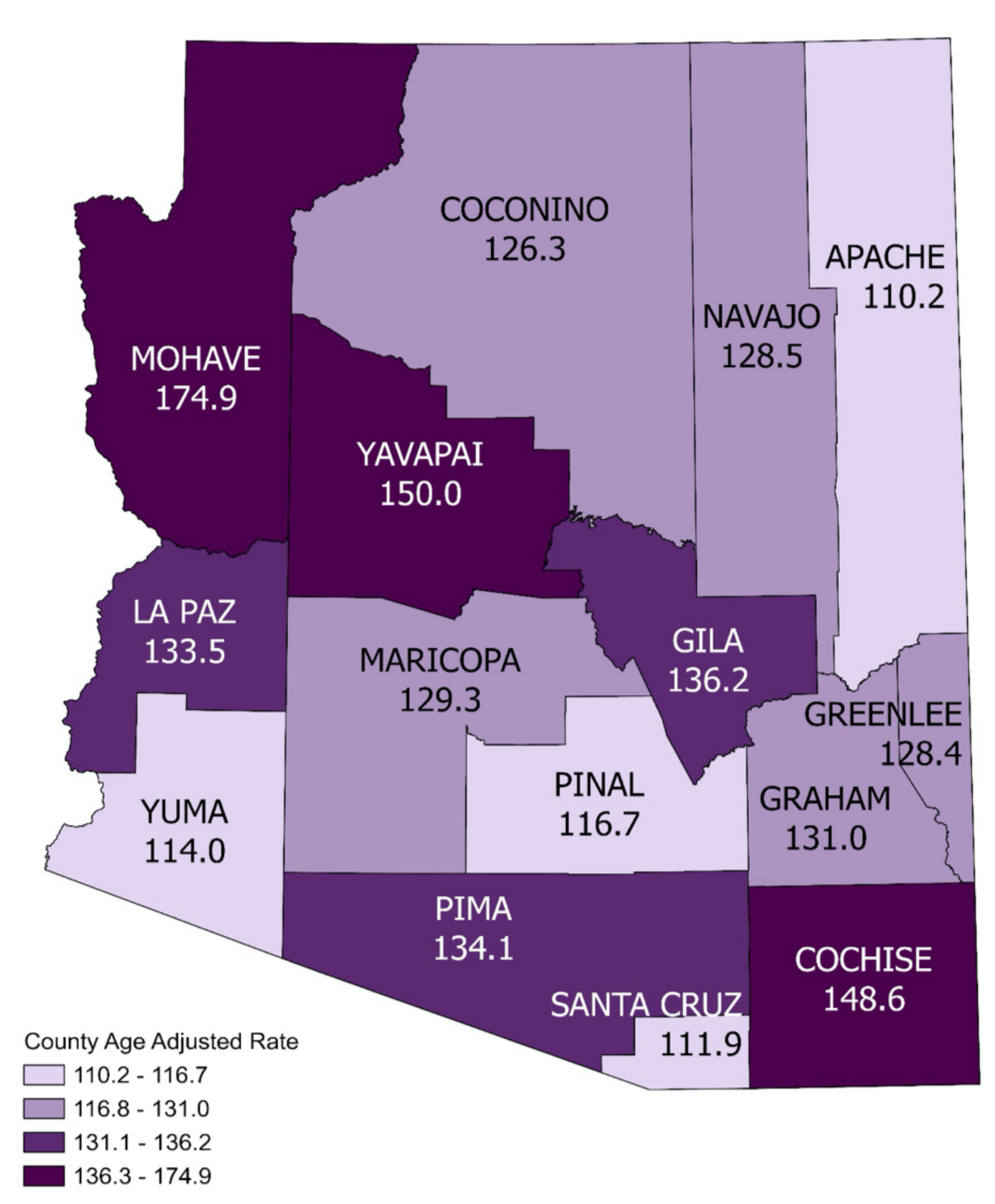


In 2020, a total of **12,671** Arizonans died from cancer which is the equivalent of **35** deaths per day
